BOAT PARK AGREEMENT FOR VISITING VESSELS

I/We agree to abide by the following conditions as set by the MANTA committee:

1. Be a bona fide visitor as determined by the committee
2. Notify the committee of your wish to use the boat park storage facility and place the vessel in the site as directed by the committee
3. Prior to occupying the site, pay the appropriate fees as set by the committee (\$25 for gate key plus \$100 per month or part thereof unless otherwise approved)
4. As a visitor the period of occupation will be no longer than six months. Further negotiation with the committee will be necessary if a longer term is required.
5. Use appropriate measures to secure the vessel during the cyclone season.
6. Keep the site clean and tidy and remove any rubbish from the area.
7. Remove and store elsewhere inflammable liquids, fuels, oils, and LP gas.
8. No residing on board the vessel while it is stored in the MANTA Boat Park.
9. Agree to indemnify MANTA against any claims brought by third parties in respect of personal injury or property damage caused by the visiting vessel or associated equipment.
10. On vacating the site, leave it in a clean and tidy condition. If not carried out within seven days of vacating the site an additional cleaning fee of \$100 will be paid to the committee.
11. If the vessel is not removed from the boat park after the expiration of the agreed period the owner/s will be liable for additional fees as determined by the committee. MANTA may dispose of the vessel pursuant to the Disposal of Uncollected Goods Act or other relevant act, regulation or authority.
12. MANTA may retain the vessel in its possession until all amounts due to MANTA are paid in full.
